Waiver Form for Lethbridge Therapeutic Riding Association
RELEASE, WAIVER OF CLAIM, AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK WARNING
PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

The Lethbridge Therapeutic Riding Association will be referred to as the "LTRA".

The undersigned acknowledges that activities undertaken at the facility and lands of Rainbow Riding Center (the facility at LTRA) have inherent risks. The LTRA will endeavour to provide reasonable services and to act reasonably, although the LTRA is not able to assure you that the services they, or anyone else at the LTRA facility or associated lands provides or the horses and animals at the LTRA, will meet your needs or provide a trouble free or risk free experience.

The undersigned releases the LTRA, its directors, agents and employees from all liability and waives, as against the LTRA, its directors, agents and employees all recourse, causes of action or claims of any kind for loss or damages, including any consequential loss or damage, arising from the presence or activities of the undersigned, or anyone for whom the undersigned is a guardian or caregiver at the LTRA's facility, or any associated lands, and voluntarily accepts the legal risk associated with the presence or activities of the undersigned or anyone for whom the undersigned is a guardian or caregiver at the LTRA facility or associated lands, thereby expressly giving up any right of action from the physical risk arising from any actions initiated by the undersigned or, by anyone who is not affiliated with the LTRA, who is acting on the undersigned's behalf.

The undersigned further acknowledges and agrees that:

- Equestrian activities can be very dangerous and expose all participants or observers to many risks and hazards, some of which are inherent in the very nature of the sport.
- As a result of the aforementioned risks and hazards, I may suffer personal injury, property loss or even death as a result of my presence and actions of the facility of the LTRA and any activities I engage in with the LTRA, or in or around the LTRA facility.
- Some of the risks and hazards are foreseeable, but many others are not.

I nevertheless, freely and voluntarily assume all possible risks, and hazards and acknowledge that my use of or attendance at the facilities at LTRA or its associated lands, while participating in or observing any activities, shall be entirely at my own risk, or at the risk of those for whom I am a guardian or caregiver. I understand that LTRA, its directors, agents and employees do not assume any responsibility or liability whatsoever for my actions while I am observing or engaged in any of the activities or using any of the facilities in any way.

By signing this Release, Waiver of Claim and Assumption of Risk Warning, I will be FOREVER PRECLUDED FROM SUING OR OTHERWISE CLAIMING AGAINST LTRA, its directors, agents and employees for any loss or damage or injury or death I may sustain as a result of my own actions.

I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the LTRA, its directors, agents and employees from any and all 3rd party claims initiated as a result of any act or omission of the undersigned or anyone for whom the undersigned is a guardian at the LTRA facility, or associated lands, for events alleged to have occurred at the LTRA facilities or associated lands.

I understand that the LTRA intends all users or observers of activities at the LTRA facility, or any associated lands, sign this Release, Waiver of Claim and Assumption of Risk Warning. I have carefully read and accept the terms of this Release, Waiver of Claim and Assumption of Risk Warning. I acknowledge that no representation of fact or opinion, threat or inducement has been made or given by the LTRA, its directors, agents or employees to induce the signing of this Release.

This Release, Waiver of Claim and Assumption of Risk are binding upon myself, my heirs, my executors, administrators, personal representatives, and assigns.

Public Riding Lessons:

Who: Adults & Children 6+

Cost: \$35/hr (6 week session cost \$210)
\$30 Membership Fee

Deposit: \$35/person plus \$30 membership fee due with registration to hold your spot, balance is due first lesson.

Times: Beginners 6pm – 7pm

Definition of a Beginner: Someone who has limited knowledge or experience with horses, maybe rode when younger or not at all.

Skills Acquired during our lessons: Safety on and off the horse, tacking up properly, open and direct rein effects, walk and trot How to be safe on horses, whether here or on a trail ride.

Intermediate: 7-8 pm

Definition of an Intermediate Rider: Someone who is familiar with horses, may have own horses but wants to refine their skills.

If you have a helmet and boots, please bring them with you. If not they can be provided.

Rider Rules

All students are required to register before lessons begin.

All students are required to wear long pants.

All students are asked to be on time. If students have not arrived by 10 after the hour they will not be able to ride. Their horse will be taken out of the arena.
